([April 1, 1912](#) - [February 1, 2006](#)) was a [pitcher](#) in [Major League Baseball](#) who played for the [Detroit Tigers](#) (1936-1938), [Boston Red Sox](#) (1939), [St. Louis Browns](#) (1939[*end*]), [Chicago White Sox](#), (1942-1944), [New York Yankees](#) (1946) and [Washington Senators](#) (1946). Wade batted and threw left handed. He was nicknamed "[Whistlin' Jake](#)". His younger brother, [Ben](#), was also a major league pitcher.
