

Smyrna Defeats Atlantic In Court Doubleheader

Smyrna swept both ends of a basketball doubleheader Tuesday night at the home court as they defeated the Atlantic Pirates 45-21 in the boys game, and 37-21 in the girls encounter.

Smyrna Leads

Smyrna was ahead throughout both games as they took a 6-2 lead in the feature contest at the end of the first quarter. At halftime they had extended their lead to 21-13, and at the end of three quarters the score stood Smyrna 37, Atlantic 17.

The Pirates were held to four points in the final canto and the final score saw the Smyrna team well ahead 45-21.

Leading the scoring parade for the winners was Ken Davis with 16 points as Terry Gillikin popped in 14.

Barney Hill of the Pirates tied for high-score honors as he made 16 points for the losers.

Smyrna had a 9-4 lead, at the end of the first quarter, extended it to 16-8 at halftime, went to 27-21 at the end of three quarters and finished up with a 37-21 win.
