

Harkers Island, Salter Path Win

Harkers Island took two games from Mill Creek over the weekend and Salter Path defeated Marshallberg. Saturday found Mill Creek at Straits, where they were defeated 7-4. Frank Moore was the winning pitcher. He gave up 2 hits and struck out 7.

West Taylor, losing pitcher, was relieved by Lloyd Culpepper in the first inning, after 5 men had been to bat. Harkers Island scored four runs in the first and made 9 hits.
