

# Devils Lose 3-2 Decision in 9th, Down Pamlico 2-0 in Make-up Bout

The Blue Devils lost a 3-2 decision Thursday to Pamlico in a one-inning continuation of a game rained out Tuesday, then went on to defeat the Hurricanes 2-0 in a make-up contest. Both bouts were staged at Smyrna.

Coach Frank Curling's club finished the eighth inning in a 2-all knot with Pamlico Tuesday. They lost it by one in the ninth Thursday. Kenny Lewis took the loss for Smyrna, finishing out the nine-inning ball game. C. H. Styron came in to claim the win for Pamlico.

Wayne singled, stole second and

came home on a single by Ireland. The Devils threatened, but couldn't score in their turn at bat. Ted Lewis walked, moved to third on a single by Tommy McGee, but was left there.

In the second game Thursday, originally scheduled as the clubs' season opener, then cancelled because of rain, Arnold Davis registered his first pitching win of the season.

He struck out six, walked none and allowed three hits, all singles. Styron remained on the mound for the Hurricanes. He struck out none, walked none and gave up three hits in accepting the loss.

The Blue Devils scored in the third and sixth innings. Ted Lewis reached first on a fielding error. Jimmy Bradford's double brought him home.

Bradford picked up the second run in the sixth. An error put him on base. He stole second, and scored on a double by Charles Lawrence.

Smyrna left four stranded in the game. The Hurricanes left three aboard. The visitors' biggest threat came in the fourth inning, with men on first and second.
