

# Salter Path Wins Saltwater Title

Salter Path defeated Harkers Island 4-1 in the final playoff to win the Saltwater League championship for 1952.

Frank Cahoon and Charles Freeman were the heroes for Salter Path. Cahoon's fine pitching held Harkers Island to one run over the seven innings. A hit, error, and walk set the stage in the sixth for Freeman's tie-breaking double, a long drive to right center field which scored two runners.
