

Morehead City Eagles Score Six Runs In Final Inning to Down Smyrna, 17-11

The Morehead City Eagles scored 17 runs on 12 hits and 14 Smyrna errors Thursday afternoon to hand the home-standing Blue Devils a 17-11 defeat. Kenny Davis went all the way for the losers. Bobby McIntosh started for the Eagles but was driven from the box in the second inning and was replaced by John Glancy, who was given credit for the win.

Each team came up with four runs in the first inning. Smyrna added four more in the second inning after the Eagles had pushed one run across in the top of the second. In the third inning the Eagles scored two more in the top half of the frame, and the Blue Devils collected two more to make the score read 10-7 in favor of Smyrna.

Glancy began to settle down in the fourth inning, allowing but one run in that inning and holding the Blue Devils scoreless during the last three. The Eagles scored twice in the fourth and tied the score at 11 all with two more runs in the fifth inning.

The Eagles were held scoreless in the sixth inning, but in the top of the seventh they drove in six big runs to break the tie and put the game on ice. Glancy handcuffed the Blue Devil hitters in the bottom half of the seventh.

Four Eagles collected two hits in five trips to the plate. They were Jackie McQueen, Jimmy Lawrence, James Guthrie and Glancy. Davis and Woody Hancock were the only Blue Devils to collect two hits.
