

Russell, Lasitter Pace Eagles Past Pamlico

The Morehead City Eagles captured first place in every event with the exception of the mile run to breeze the Pamlico high school track team by a score of 64-43 in a dual meet Monday afternoon on the Morehead City dogtrack.

Pacing the Eagles to victory was speedster Ronald Russell who garnered first place in the 100, 200 and 440-yard dashes in addition to anchoring the mile relay team that came in ahead of Pamlico.

Footballer Mokey Lasitter also came through as expected with a double victory in the shot put and discus throw.
