

# Braves Take Doubleheader From Louisburg; 7-2, 6-2

LOUISBURG - The Chowan College Braves slashed out 23 hits in two games as they captured a doubleheader from Louisburg College Tuesday.

The Braves closed out the first game with a 7-2 victory and collected five runs in the last inning of the second game to win, 6-2.

The Braves tagged Louisburg

pitchers Don Johnson and Butch Wheeler in the first game for 13 hits.

Vick Camechis and Kenny Myrick each had three hits in four trips to plate for the Braves in the first contest. One of Myrick's hits was a double. Mack Lowery also had a line shot double for the Braves and Tom Grayson collected two hits in three times at

bat.

Johnny Beck had a perfect first game for Louisburg getting three hits in three times at bat. Tim Morton had two doubles.

Jackie Hellemis fanned six men in the first game and was credited with the victory. Don Johnson was the losing pitcher for Louisburg.

The Braves continued their hitting in the second seven inning affair banging Louisburg's no one pitcher, Butch Wheeler, for 10 hits.

Louisburg took a 2-0 lead at the end of the first inning on one hit and one error.

Chowan bounced back in the second inning to score one run.

The Louisburg lead at 2-1 held until the top of the seventh inning when the Braves hitting power broke loose scoring five runs on five hits and one error.

Chowan's Doug Barnes hurled his second three hitter of the season and fanned 11 Louisburg batters.
