

Pirates Use Walks, Errors To Defeat Blue Devils 10-6

Eight errors and nine walks gave the Swansboro Pirates a 10-6 victory over a visiting team of Smyrna Blue Devils Tuesday afternoon. The winners committed seven errors, but winning pitcher Dallas Darnell allowed only three walks.

Lewis Thomas went the distance for the Blue Devils, allowing only five hits while his teammates were picking up eight. Lack of control and shaky support in the field ruined Thomas' bid for victory.

The Blue Devils went to work in the top of the first inning to give Thomas a three-run edge. The Pirates came back to go ahead 5-3 in the bottom of the same inning.

The winners scored again in the second and fourth innings. They got two in the fifth and wound up with a single tally in the sixth.

The Blue Devils scored once in the third, fourth and fifth innings.
