## Camp Lejeune Scores 4-2 Win at New Bern

In the second round of the state baseball playoffs Thursday afternoon the Camp Lejeune Devil Pups scored unearned runs in the third and fourth innings to edge the Smyrna Blue Devils 4-2. The game was played at Kafer park, New Bern.

Everett had reached second safely when Grady Davis dropped his fly ball in right field and he scored when Wayne Davis miffed a fly ball off the bat of Dick Dube. A walk, a stolen base and a single brought home another Camp Lejeune run in the fifth inning.

Piner was the starting and losing pitcher for the Blue Devils. He went all the way, limiting Camp Lejeune to only five hits but didn't get much support afield as the Blue Devils committed four costly errors.
