

Camp Lejeune Edges Seadogs 5-4

★ **Camp Lejeune** high school edged Beaufort 5-4 Wednesday afternoon in a baseball game played at Lejeune.

Righthander R. Potts of Lejeune limited the Seadogs to only three hits, all singles, in leading his team to the win. Snuffy Willis started on the mound for Beaufort and went all the way giving up 5 runs on a total of seven hits.

Beaufort's three hits came on singles by Chuck Lewis and Ray and Butch Hassell. Everett, of Camp Lejeune, got the only extra base hit of the day when he slammed out a triple. His teammate Stafford collected two hits, while Stroud, Ware, Keown, and Chapman all chipped in with one single apiece.

The Seadogs scored their first run in the second inning when Butch Hassell reached base with a single. This was followed by a strikeout by catcher Joe Powell and a walk to pitcher Snuffy Willis. Chuck Lewis then sent a ground ball to the shortstop and Butch was safe on an error on the catcher.

In the fourth inning, first baseman John Smith reached base on an error. Butch Hassell then lined out and Joe Powell walked. After Snuffy Willis had struck out, a passed ball by the Lejeune catcher allowed Smith to score from third with the second run of the ball game for the Seadogs.

Ray Hassell singled to open the fifth and Leon Thomas walked advancing Hassell to second. Bill Morgan then fanned and Pud Hassell grounded out. John Smith then hit a grounder and two wild throws

allowed Ray Hassell and Thomas to cross the plate and Smith wound up on second base.

With the score tied at four all, Lejeune won the game when Keown hit a sacrifice fly that drove in Everett, who had opened up with a triple.

Willis struck out four men in taking the loss and Potts had eight whiffs to his credit. Beaufort also was charged with three errors in the game.
