

Seadogs Lose Bout At Pamlico, 6-1

The Seadogs allowed Pamlico five unearned runs Wednesday, and left nine men stranded, to suffer a 6-1 defeat on the Hurricanes' home field. The loss was Beaufort's third in four outings.

Paul Biermann knocked out a triple in the first inning, but got no farther. The Seadogs loaded the bases in the fourth, but couldn't score.

Their lone run came in the seventh. Thompson Lewis doubled, then came home on a single by Biermann.

Pamlico collected two runs in the third inning, on one hit and two Seadog errors. The Hurricanes added two in the fourth and two more in the sixth, on five hits and two errors.

James Lupton went the distance for Pamlico to claim the victory. He struck out six, walked two and allowed six hits. Thompson Lewis went five innings to take the loss. He was relieved in the sixth by John Way.

The Seadogs report a change

in schedule. They'll host a game with Smyrna Wednesday, instead of Tuesday as originally scheduled.
