Early Years - 1923/24 Won for 16 Years Straight! Won more than 160 games!



Jack Dudley, Downeast Portraits of the Past said, "Although academic achievements were primary, probably the most remembered achievement of the early years was the winning record of the girls' basketball team. Beginning with the first school year, 1923-24, the girls' teams won every game for the next 16 years (1939). The first games were on dirt courts and travel to other schools was difficult."
- B. Based on Joe (Boy) Willis research, the Smyrna Women team won 16 straight years, winning more than 160 games! In comparison the Beaufort Men's Basketball team won 91 games over four (4) years from 1958 to 1961, which is a standing school record for NC Men's Basketball for 90 years.

Joe said, "This is a record that is unbelievable, one that gives us a great deal of pride in our mothers, grandmothers and friends...We should give thanks to those great women for setting the bar for all of us that played sports at Smyrna high school..."
