

# 3 East Hurlers Blenk West All-Stars 8-0

→ The East All-Stars used a combination of tight pitching and long ball hitting last Sunday afternoon to down the West All-Stars 8-0 in the County League All-Star game at Smyrna.

Lefthanders Tommy Salter, Pud Hassell and Braxton Piner shared mound duties for the East and the trio gave up only three hits, all singles.

The East, meanwhile, wasted no time in jumping on West starter Gary Guthrie for two runs in the first inning. Leadoff hitter Bob Bass reached base on a West error and was on first when John Hamilton blasted a long homerun into the woods behind left field.

That was all of the scoring by either team until the fourth inning when the East scored two more runs on a walk, an error and a single. After Crawford Pigott had walked and Mack Pigott was safe on an error, second baseman Harold Bass delivered a single that scored both runners.

As the first batter up in the sixth inning, Mack Pigott gave the East a 5-0 lead with his homerun over left field. Two walks, a double, and a fielder's choice plated another run in the inning for the East.

The East scored single runs in each the seventh and eighth innings to round out the scoring for the game. The big hits that scored the runs were a single by Mack Pigott and a double by John Hamilton.
