

Havelock Defeats Pamlico by 5-3

Havelock defeated the Pamlico High school Hurricanes 5-3 Friday afternoon on the Rams' home field. The win gives Havelock a 7-0 record so far.

Tommy Dees opened the first inning for the Rams with a single. He stole second and advanced to third on a sacrifice by Jim Fagley. Brickly Scoggins reached first on an error that saw Dees score.

A single by Phil Buzzelli moved Scoggins to second. He went to third on a single by Clark Totherow, and scored on a sacrifice by Rick Pierce.

The Rams added another run in the second inning. J. R. Godwin got on on an error. An over-throw at first put Fred Fritz on base, and both men advanced on the play.

Dees reached first on another error, while Godwin was picked off. A single by Fagley drove in Fritz.

Pierce singled to open the third inning, but was forced at second on a fielder's choice, a hit by John Olkowski. The throw to first for the double play was wild, and

Olkowski went to second. He scored on a double by Godwin.

The Hurricanes managed one run in the fourth and two more in the top of the fifth. Lupton, losing pitcher, slammed a two-run homer in the fifth over the left field fence, best hit of the day.

Havelock got run No. 5 in the bottom of the fifth. Muzzelli singled, but was forced out at second on an infield grounder by Totherow. Pierce reached first on an error, while Totherow rounded the bases and scored.

Fritz was the winning pitcher. He was relieved in the fifth by Ray Hardison. Together, they struck out eight, walked one and gave up three hits. Lupton went the distance for the Hurricanes, striking out one, walking none, and allowing nine hits.

Pamlico committed six errors in the contest, against three for the Rams.
