

Eagles Continue Streak, Blast Smyrna Nine 10-1

Morehead City high's baseball team continued its victory string Tuesday when the Eagles swamped Smyrna 10-1. The Eagles picked up their ten runs on only five hits as they were aided by the eight free passes given up by R. Lawrence, Smyrna's pitcher.

Walter Thomas, Morehead City hurler, turned in another excellent performance as he limited Smyrna to three hits. Thomas struck out 14 of the batters who faced him and gave up no bases on balls. Lawrence struck out 12 of the Eagles.

The Eagles picked up their first run in the second inning on two free passes and an error. Jimmy Willis, second man up in the inning, walked and advanced to second when Horace Willis also received a base on balls. Willis scored from second when the catcher threw the ball away in an attempted pick-off.

The Eagles bunched four hits and a base on balls in the fourth inning to add three more runs to their total. Seven men went to the plate for the Eagles in the big inning. The three runs were scored by Bobby Willis, Jimmy Willis and Jerry Conner.

The Eagles added six more runs in the sixth inning on one hit, four free passes and an error. Timothy Jones led off the inning by walking, went to second when Conner reached on an error and scored on Wade's single, the only hit of the inning. Hewitt then sacrificed and Gil Faber, Thomas and Bobby Willis all walked to bring in three more runs. Bobby Bass sacrificed to bring in the remainder of the runs. Jimmy Willis, ninth

Eagle to go to the plate in the inning, struck out to end the frame.

Smyrna got its one run in the last of the seventh. O. Davis led off with a double, went to second on Lina's single and scored when Arthur reached on an error. The one run didn't make much difference, however, as the Eagles' lead was more than enough.
