

Eagles Slaughter White Oak, Morehead Girls Lose 63-29

Beaufort's new fire alarm arrived and was installed Tuesday. The alarm numbers are ringing correctly once again.

Morehead City's hoopsters journeyed to White Oak Tuesday night and posted a runaway 82-33 victory in the feature contest after losing the preliminary game 63-29.

The Eagles jumped out to a 19-8 lead at the end of the first quarter and extended their advantage to 38-12 at halftime. At the end of three quarters the margin had been increased to 57-22.

Wayne Cheek, elongated center for the Eagles, paced his team in scoring 39 points, the high for a Morehead City basketball player. He also had 43 rebounds.

Runnerup honors for the victors went to Bradley McIntosh with 18 markers.

For the losers Dickerson was high pointmaker with 20.

The preliminary contest saw the White Oak girls take a 12-5 lead at the end of the initial quarter, and maintain a 24-15 advantage at halftime. The second half found the home team going all out as they tallied 20 points in the third quarter and 19 in the final period to complete their rout of the Eaglettes.

Ann Pittman, high scorer for the White Oak sextet, led her team with 35 points. Varina O'Neal scored an even dozen.
