# Vest Stars Blast East Team 1-3 Sunday in First Game

The West All-Stars with 11 runs and 11 hits swamped the East team Sunday afternoon at the Morehead ball park with an 11-3 score in the first annual All-Star game.

By Bass of Morehead City credited with the win although he allowed all three of the East's runs in the first on three hits and a walk. He then settled down and held the East team to 1 hit and 2 runs in his remaining two in-
