## ● Pud Hassell Strikes Out 14

In a fracas-filled extra-inning baseball game, the Beaufort Seadogs pushed across a run in the ninth inning to defeat Camp Lejeune high school 5-4 Tuesday afternoon in Beaufort.

Lefty Pud Hassell started on the mound for the Seadogs and went the entire route, limiting Camp Lejeune to only three hits while striking out a total of 14 men.

His teammates, on the other hand, collected eight hits off the combined efforts of righthanders Kelly and McArvill of Camp Lejeune.

The game was featured by rough play on both sides throughout and the first baseman for Camp Lejeune, Shelton, was ejected from the game for a ball throwing incident in which he threw a baseball at Bill Morgan of the Seadogs.
