

Beaufort Scores 22-0 County League Win

In County League baseball Sunday Beaufort pounded out 17 hits off three Newport pitchers to register a 22-0 win in a game played at Newport.

Tommy Salter and Pud Hassell combined to shutout Newport on two hits. Both of the Newport hits, one off Salter and one off Hassell, were singles.

Beaufort scored in every inning except the fourth and the sixth, as they sent a total of 55 men to bat in the nine-inning contest. They opened the scoring with two runs in the first inning and then added three in the second, seven in the third, four in the fifth, three in the

seventh, one in the eighth and two in the ninth.

Outfielder Jim Fodrie led the Beaufort hitting barrage, getting four hits in four trips to the plate. Included in his total were a double and a triple. Roy Cockerham collected three hits in seven trips and James Holland had two for five for the winners.

Salter started on the mound for Beaufort and was relieved in the sixth inning by Hassell. Salter struck out 10 Newport batters and Hassell whiffed three.
