

# Croom, Lewis Combine To Toss No-Hitter at Havelock

In a baseball game at Havelock Friday afternoon, Paris Croom and Chuck Lewis combined pitching efforts to turn in the second consecutive no-hitter by the Beaufort pitching staff. Parris started on the mound for the Seadogs and pitched 2 2/3 innings before he developed a sore arm and had to give way to Lewis who finished up.

Beaufort batters pounded Havelock starter, Zimmer for 10 hits to record a 7-0 win. The win was the seventh in a row for the Seadogs and left their undefeated record intact.

The big hit of the day for Beaufort was a bases-loaded homerun by Pud Hassell in the top of the third inning. Hassell teed off on a Zimmer pitch and poled the ball over the centerfield barrier with Alton Hill, Jackie Gardner and Johnny Hassell on base. An error, a single by Gardner and a walk to

Johnny loaded the bases.

In the 2 2/3 innings he worked, Parris struck out seven and walked four. Lewis, his relief, struck out four and issued three free passes. Zimmer, the loser, recorded six strike outs and walked four in addition to surrendering 10 hits.

Collecting four of Beaufort's 10 hits were Leslie Croom and Ray Hassell who each had two hits in four trips to the plate.

This afternoon the Seadogs travel to Bayboro to play Pamlico and Friday afternoon they play Newport high school at Newport.
