Elvin Davis Tops Tidewater Batters

Elvin Davis of Marshallberg climbed to the top of the Tidewater League batting averages last weekend, rounding out his play in seven games with the fat average of .500 reached by virtue of 15 hits in 30 trips to the plate.

Next to Davis is R. Jones of New Bern with a .423 mark. Others in the choice circle and their averages are Wallace, Morehead City, .400; Benton, Morehead City, .400; Godwin, Newport, .371; Otkowski, Marshallberg, .367; and DeJohn, Midway Park, .356.

Johnson of Marshallberg retained his pitching lead with a four won, none lost, record and the top mark of 53 batters fanned. Cahoon of Morehead City is second in the won-lost slate with two victories and no losses to his credit. Others in order are Johnson, Beaufort; Oakley, New Bern; Webb, Morehead City; Driver, Marshallberg; and Diem, Midway Park.

Webb of Morehead holds second high in the strikeout department with 4 fanned. Others are Diem, 34; Taylor, Newport, 29; and Stewart, Newport, 26.

Smith of Newport holds the lead in the runs batted in department with 16 to his credit. Tied for second place with 15 each are Stoy and Holt of Morehead. R. Haskett of Newport is third with 11. Haskett of Newport and Oakley of New Bern are high in home runs with three each. All averages are compiled by C. H. Lockett, league statistician.
