

Beaufort Extends Streak As Pud Two-Hits Hurricanes

The Beaufort Seadogs drew one step closer to an undefeated baseball season Tuesday afternoon when they scored an 8-2 win over the Pamlico Hurricanes in a game played on the Pamlico diamond.

Lefthander Pud Hassell drew the starting nod for the Seadogs and he turned in another sparkling pitching performance as he limited the Hurricanes to only a pair of hits and single runs in the second and seventh innings.

Beaufort jumped out in front early in the game as they scored two runs in the top of the first inning and then added another in the second, two in the fifth, one in the sixth and two in the seventh. Chuck Lewis, leading Seadog hitter, had two triples in four trips to the plate and Pud Hassell was credited with one three-bagger.

The losing pitcher for Pamlico was Potter who went all the way,

giving up nine hits, two walks and striking out three.

This afternoon the Seadogs will be in Newport for a game with the Hawks.
