

# Dubs Team Wins 7 To 6; Ca-Vel Goes Into Finals

Winkie's Single Following Triple By Puckett Puts Locals Ahead For Good In Burlington Tournament—Hillsboro Falls 7-5 To Ca-Vel

Burlington, June 28.—(Special)—Wilkie's single in the last of the ninth gave Dubs' ball team of Durham a 7-6 victory over Plaid Mills here today in the opening tiff of the second day's district semi-pro competition, which saw Ca-Vel, of Roxboro go into the finals by whipping Hillsboro 7-5 for its second win in as many days.

The Dubs decision threw the Bull City club into Wednesday's semifinal against Tower, a club which Monday defeated Golden Belt of Durham to advance.

### SPOT FIVE RUNS

The winners spotted Plaid's diamonds five runs in the first frame as the inner defense crumbled along with Puckett's control, but after the second when Roach homered for the sixth run, the Durham outfit held its opponents well in check.

Hawkins doubled to punch the first Dub run home in the third and he scored on Hick's single, but the winners failed to score again until Williams homered in the seventh. Three runs followed in the eighth as the Plaid infield erred, and the winning tally counted when Puckett tripled to score on Wilkie's hit.

Ca-Vel took its lead early by racking up four runs in the first, of them on Slaughter's first of the game. Hillsboro scored in the seventh to widen the margin.
