Newport's Hawks continued their winning ways Friday night as they posted a double victory over Atlantic at the loser's court. The Hawks won the feature game by the one-sided score of 95-25 and took the preliminary 47-35.

### Hawks Take Big Lead

Newport jumped out to a 35-8 lead at the end of the first quarter and extended their advantage to 55-8 at halftime.

The Hawks had a 40-17 advantage in the second half, to take the 95-25 decision.

Leston Gillikin was high scorer for the winners with 20 points, other Newport players to hit in double figures were Eugene Edwards 13, Larry Wallace and Berlyn Temple 12 each, and Small with 10.
