

Ward, Owens Head Loops

Plans for the Pony and Pony Grad Leagues were formulated Thursday night at an organization meeting at Erwin Auditorium.

Allan Ward Sr., was elected president of the Pony Grads (boys 15 and 16 years of age) and Clifford Cross was named vice president.

Delma Owens will serve as president of the Pony Leaguers (boys 13 and 14) with Nick Warren, athletic director of the City Recreation Dept., acting secretary of both loops.

The Pony League, which will comprise six members this summer, opens a 15-game schedule May 26 and concludes July 21, playing three games on Tuesdays and Thursdays at 4:30, 6:30 and 8:30 o'clock.
