Baseball League Hamstrung By Negligent Scorekeepers

The failure of Tidewater League scorekeepers to send their official score sheets to League Statistician Charles Jarman caused League President Ralph L. Eudy to state yesterday that in the future the rule governing fines will be strictly enforced. The rule states that a \$5 fine shall be imposed on teams that are late sending in score sheets.

President Eudy's declaration was caused by the apparent reluctance of league scorekeepers to notify the league statistician of their scores. Last week Statistician Jarman found it impossible to compute league standings since he did not receive an official report on the Midway Park - Apprentice School and Newport-Jacksonville games which were played Saturday, May 28.

This week, not a single team in the league sent in the official score of its game to Statistician Jarman, consequently no scores or standings were available for publication.

All official team scorekeepers have been urged by President Eudy, under penalty of a \$5 fine for failure to comply, to mail their score sheets in to Charles Jarman, Beaufort, immediately following their games.
