Cherry Point's high-flying baseball nine was brought down to earth Tuesday afternoon as Morehead City's Tidewater League team handed the Marine Corps sportsmen a 3-0 Independence Day defeat.

The Marines threw in their best pitchers to stem the tide but civilian power told the tale as Morehead scored twice in the fifth and once in the eighth to reap the win.
