Seadogs Score 6-0 Victory Against Stars

THE BEAUFORT Seadogs shutout the Broad & Gales Creek Stars 6-0 Sunday in a Coastal Carolina Baseball League contest at Gales Creek.

The star of the game was a Seadog pitcher Dallas Arthur, who fanned 20 Stars, walked only one and allowed just one hit.

The loser was George Viereck. He struck out 7, walked 2 and gave up 11 hits.

BEAUFORT was charged with one error in the game, Broad & Gales Creek with 3.

Manley Gaskill led the Seadogs at bat with 2 for 4, a single and a home run. The Seadogs' pitching standout, Arthur, took one turn at bat and came up with a home run.

Also getting hits for the Seadogs were Willie Johnson, 2 for 4, a single and a double; and Milton Scott, 2 for 4, singles.

RODNEY KEMP got the Stars' only hit, a single in the ninth inning.

The victory gives Beaufort a 5-2 record, tying the Seadogs and the Stars for second place in the '73 league race. Pollocksville and Swansboro are currently tied for the lead each with a 5-1 record.
