

# Eagles Claw Erwin 63-41 In Tourney at Swansboro

## Seadogs, Eagles Travel Collision Course Again

Both Morehead City and Beaufort have reached the semi-finals of the district 2 AA conference, and depending on the outcome of two games, another Morehead City-Beaufort basketball game may be in the offing.

The finals of the tournament begin Saturday at Swansboro at 8 p.m. Games yet to be played are Beaufort vs. Roseboro-Salemburg and Morehead City vs. 71st.

If both of the Carteret teams win, they will meet again for another round on the courts. Morehead City won over Erwin 63-41 and Beaufort downed Four Oaks 65-54 to reach the semi-finals.

Beaufort plays Roseboro-Salemburg and Morehead's Eagles play 71st tonight. Time is 7:30 for the Morehead game and 9 for the Beaufort game.

Morehead City's Eagles came up with a 22-point margin in their first game in the AA district 2 tourney at Swansboro Wednesday.

The Eagles beat their opponent, Erwin high school, 63-41. Morehead's Jimmy Smithwick ended up the game with a big 19 points, George Styron got 17 and Bernard Leary 13. Erwin's players in the two-cipher bracket were Horne with 14, Woodall with 10.

At the foul line, the Eagles averaged .71, a small fraction indeed over Erwin's .70. George Styron sank 5 for 5, while four Erwin players got perfect records.

Morehead City consistently out-classed Erwin in quarter scores except for the third quarter, when Erwin got 13 to the Eagles' 7. However, the 10-point lead in the first and later additions kept the game safely in the hand of the Morehead team.

Heaviest scoring came in the fourth, with Morehead adding up 25 points to an 11 for Erwin. Score in the first and second quarters

was 17 and 14 for the Eagles and 7 and 10 for the Erwin boys.

The Eagles will meet the winner of the Jones Central-71st game tonight at 7 in Swansboro. The Jones Central-71st game was played Wednesday night.
