

Newport Drops Doubleheader To Salter Path

Salter Path leaped into second place in the County Baseball League Sunday with a double win over Newport. Salter Path trounced Newport 14-4 in the first game and took the nightcap 3-2 in six innings. Salter Path's record is now 5-2.
