

Beaufort Splits Doubleheader At Smyrna-HI

Beaufort and Smyrna-Harkers Island remain tied for second place in the county baseball loop. The teams split Sunday's doubleheader. Smyrna-Harkers Island took the first game 8-7 and Beaufort trampled the hosts 27-2 in a five-inning nightcap.

The first game star was Bill Gillikin, of Beaufort, who poled a two-run homer in the fourth inning, putting his team in a momentary lead.

Two walks and Elvin Davis' single gave Beaufort two runs in the fifth followed by two more in the sixth, highlighted by Clyde Owens' double.

Davis Doubles Twice

Smyrna-Harkers Island scored once in the second on a walk, a single, and Wilson Davis' double. They took the lead in the fourth on a three-run outburst headed by Wilson Davis' second double.

Smyrna-Harkers Island went into a 7-7 tie in the sixth when three hits, featuring Snoball Gaskill's double produced three runs.

A single by Lewis and an error by Bill Gillikin accounted for the winning tally in the seventh. Red Davis, who relieved Wilson Davis in the seventh, was credited with the win. Clyde Owens absorbed the loss, giving up 11 bingles.

Beaufort slammed 10 Smyrna-Harkers Island hurlers for 17 safeties in the second game for the 27-2 triumph. Among the hits were four triples and three doubles. Leading hitter was M. Peterson, who is batting 1.000.

Score 12 Times

Beaufort scored six in the first, four in the third, five in the fourth, and 12 in the fifth.

Smyrna-Harkers Island scored twice in the second on Curvis Hamilton's triple and two walks. Mac Pigott was charged with the loss. Cal Hodges was the winner.
