

# Morehead Is Selected as Site Of County Loop All-Star Game

→ The county baseball league all-star game will be July 4 starting at 2:30 p.m. at Morehead City this year, stated league officials and managers at a meeting Wednesday at Beaufort.

The game will be nine innings and between stars of the teams representing the east and west division of the league.

→ Teams in the east are Beaufort, Atlantic, and Smyrna-Harkers Island. Teams in the west are Morehead City, Salter Path, and Newport.

Each team will be represented by six players if there is a playing manager. If the manager is non-playing the team may send seven members.

## Pilots to Pick Players

The managers of the teams in each division will get together and select their players, and then select one manager for the all-star team. The other two managers will be coaches.

Division managers will also select three pitchers for each team. Pitchers will be limited to three innings each.

If the game is rained out on the Fourth, or has to be cancelled for any other reason, it will be played at 8 p.m. July 7 at Beaufort.

Three umpires from the Cherry Point Umpires Association will be selected for the game.

## Decide Playoff

Other business taken up by league managers and officials was the matter of the May 23 suspended game between Beaufort and Salter Path.

They decided that the game should continue from where play was stopped with the same lineup.

The game was halted at the end of four innings with Beaufort ahead 8-5 because of the 6 p.m. curfew. Play will resume in the top of the fifth with Beaufort at bat.

The managers also included in the league by-laws that anything not covered in the by-laws be referred to the general rule book and let it govern the case.

The new by-law was made effective June 23.

## Protests Called Off

The protested games were called off by the protestors. Atlantic called off its protest of the May 9 tilt with Salter Path. Salter Path called off its protest with Morehead City on June 6.
