

Pigott Singles in Winning Run in Smyrna-HI 7-6 Win

Crawford Pigott singled in the winning run Wednesday as Smyrna-Harkers Islands squeaked through with a 7-6 win over the Coast Guard Cutter Agassiz team in a tilt at Smyrna.

The game was a seven-inning tilt and at the end of the seventh the game was tied. Managers Sells and Wilson Davis decided on a sudden death finish.

With the score tied at 6-all going into the last of the eighth, O'Conner, Agassiz hurler, walked Al Wolfe, who took second on a passed ball.

Agassiz Manager Earle Sells lifted O'Conner and called upon Lloyd Culpepper to pitch to Pigott. Pigott promptly spanked a single that scored Wolfe with the winning run.

Smyrna-HI drew first blood in the first, scoring once. In the top of the third the Agassiz scored three runs, taking the lead, 3-1.

But the victors came back with two more in their half of the third to tie the game at 3-3. The Agassiz went out ahead again in the fourth, 5-3, on two runs, adding another in the top of the sixth, making it 6-3.

Smyrna-HI got back into the game, exploding for three runs in the bottom half. And that's the way it stood, 6-6, until the bottom of the eighth.

Davis was the winning hurler with O'Conner the loser.
