Atlantic Rallies to Win

In the nightcap a five-run rally in the sixth gave Atlantic the 8-4 win. Four singles, two errors, and an intentional walk accounted for the tallies.

Beaufort scored once and Atlantic twice in the initial frame. Atlantic added another in the fourth when John Willis singled Harry Gerock home from second.

Beaufort tied the game at 3-all in the fifth. Parkins led off with a double, took third on Peterson's infield out and scored on Owens' double. Owens took third on a passed ball and scored on Don Willis's throwing error to home.

Beaufort Leads

Beaufort went ahead 4-3 in the sixth when Parkins singled Gillikin home. Atlantic came to bat in the last of the sixth and promptly started a rally that netted the win.

Owens was clubbed for 11 hits led by Joe and Don Willis, each with two for three Parkins led the nine-hit attack on Morris with three for three, followed by Elvin Davis and Gillikin, two for three.
