ATLANTIC — With eighth and ninth inning rallies, the Atlantic A's came from behind to edge the hard-luck Bays 7-6.

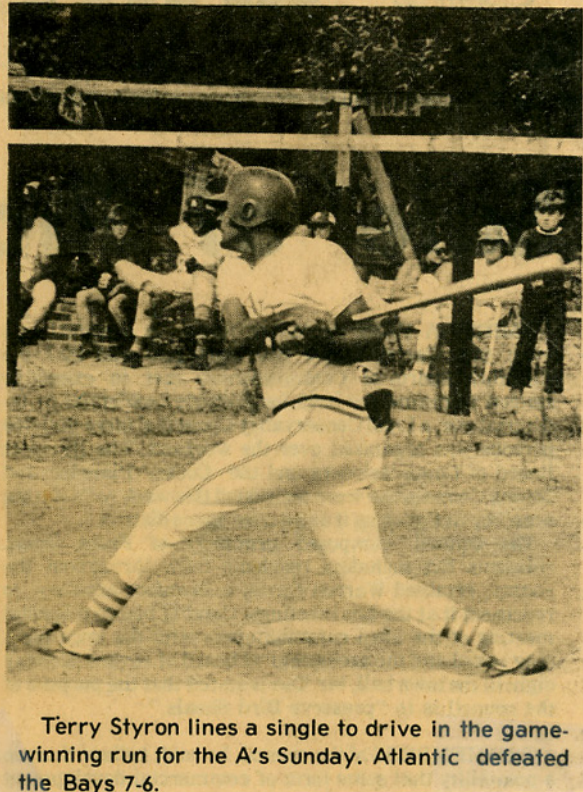
