

Beaufort Loses Two Games

Beaufort lost two heart breaking defeats by a one-run margin over the weekend, both of the losses occurring Sunday at Havelock though Beaufort and Havelock played 10 innings of baseball at Beaufort Saturday.

Saturday's game was knotted 11-11 at the end of 10 innings with darkness almost falling when the Beaufort and Havelock managers agreed that the game should be continued Sunday at Havelock. Sunday Havelock scored one run in the top of the 11th while Beaufort failed to score to give Havelock the win.

In the regular game Sunday Havelock made four runs in the first inning off of three hits and three errors to take a lead that Beaufort never overcame. Havelock won, 4-3.

Piner started on the mound for Beaufort Saturday and was relieved after four-and-a-third innings by Don Koontz who struck out eight men in the next five-and-two-thirds stanzas. Sunday Fred Taylor went in to pitch the 11th inning and received credit for the loss.

Havelock's hitting was well-placed with five players making more than one hit. R. Norman led with three for four and was the player who ran in the winning run in the 11th off a hit by Hodges. Other Havelock hitters were V. Norman, M. Norman, Hodges and Boyd.

Ray Hassell and Carl Sadler with two for five each were best for Beaufort. Hassell scored the run that tied the game up for Beaufort in the eighth when Russell managed to hit.
