

Butch Hassell Led County Scorers

→ To the surprise of no one, final statistics on the 1959-60 basketball season found Beaufort's Butch Hassell once again the top scorer in the county.

Post season tournament performances do not figure in a player's seasonal average.

Playing in fewer games than any of the other top scorers from the other schools, Butch amassed a total of 381 points, an average of

25.4 for the 15 contests.

His 50 points scored against Newport established an all-time high for the Seadog sharpshooter and was also the top performance by a county player this year.

It eclipsed by 10 the 40 points that Curt Nelson of Smyrna scored against Morehead City.
