Beaufort Tops Balloting With Four Selections

A forward sextet that has scored a total of 3,600 points this year and six of the finest back-court performers in the county comprise the 1960-61 NEWS-TIMES All-County girls' team.

As with the All-County team picked for the boys, Beaufort high school led the balloting in the All-Star aggregation for the girls. The Seadog school led all others with four players being named to the team. Newport and Smyrna placed three girls each on the squad and Atlantic garnered two of the All-County positions.

Forwards Lynda Chadwick and Lynn Peterson and guards Fredda Kay Garner and Judy Pake were all named to this year's team. All-county berths at Atlantic went to

Bonnie Brickhouse and Jencey Mason. Smyrna girls selected included Carolyn Phelps and guards Linda Willis and Elizabeth Styron. Newport's fine pair of forwards, Jenny Lynn Garner and Margaret Lilly plus senior guard Lana Linebarger were the All-County selections from the Hawk school.

Only two of the players, Carolyn Phelps and Margaret Lilly, are repeaters from last year's All-County team.

The leading scorer among All-County forwards this year is Carolyn Phelps who has tossed in a total of 658 points in 19 games for an average of 33 points per game. The blonde basket bomber teamed with high-scoring Brenda Golden to give Smyrna one of the most feared offensive duos in the county.

Bonnie Brickhouse, Atlantic's fine point-maker, finished the season with 476 points in 17 games for an average of 28 points per game. Jenny Lynn Garner and Margaret Lilly tallied 1,099 of Newport's total points with Jenny Lynn

Blue Devil Girls Outlast Beaufort in Tourney Final

The Smyrna girls are the newly-crowned county champs following their thrilling 70-66 win over the Beaufort girls Saturday night in the finals of the County Tournament at Atlantic.

The Blue Devil girls thus gained revenge for a loss suffered to Beaufort last year in the finals of the same tournament.

The two teams matched basket for basket throughout most of the first quarter but Smyrna pulled far

ahead in the second and third periods and then had to fight desperately to stave off a last-quarter rally by the Seadog sextet.

With only 40 seconds left to play in the game, Lynn Peterson pumped in a set shot that knotted the score at 66-66 after Smyrna had led by as much as 17 points in the third quarter.

Smyrna's Carolyn Phelps was then fouled on a field goal attempt and stepped to the free throw line with a chance to put her team back out in the lead. The towering point-maker made good on the charity attempt and then added a field goal for a three-point lead with 24 seconds left. She was fouled on this shot too and hit another free throw to put the game on ice. Then time ran out before Beaufort could score.

Phelps was the game's high scorer as she whiffed 5 in 44 points. Brenda Golden added 18 for the winners and Rose Arthur finished with eight points.

Beaufort's scoring was divided among Lynda Chadwick with 28 points, Lynn Peterson with 26 and Anna Salter with 12 points.

Guards seeing action in the game for Smyrna included Linda Willis, Becky Brown, Trudy Gilkin, Elizabeth Styron and Diane Willis. Beaufort coach Jim Fodrie used Fredda Garner, Norma Merrill, Judy Pake, Peggy Lewis and Mimi Gilchrist in his back court.
