

Morehead in Position To Clinch Tie for Title

With but four games remaining to be played, Morehead City holds a commanding two-game edge over second place Beaufort in the race for the Carteret County League title.

The league leaders meet Newport in a pair of games this weekend, and a sweep of the series will assure them of at least a tie for the flag. Beaufort, which must win all its four final games while hoping that Morehead City will lose two of theirs, will go against Marshallberg Saturday and Sunday.

Next week Beaufort and Morehead switch opponents, so there is no chance of a hand to hand struggle for first place. Only a reversal of form by "second division" Newport and Marshallberg can upset the present standings.

Not a Pitcher's League

A check of the season's scoring records reveals that Morehead City has averaged 10 runs per game, and has a staggering average of 16 runs per contest in five games with hapless Marshallberg.

Second place Beaufort has scored a meagre average of nine runs per game, while Newport has averaged six runs and Marshallberg seven runs, both in 19 games.

In a league in which pitching is about as prominent as that of the St. Louis Browns' minus Ned Garver, Morehead City has scored 13 or more runs in eight games. Though it was hardly worth the trouble, we have discovered that the average score of a Carteret county League game is 10-6. Next pitcher, please.
