

Smyrna Hits Winning Column With 3-2 Victory over Pamlico

The Blue Devils won a 3-2 contest at Pamlico Friday behind the pitching of sophomore Kenny Lewis.

He went all the way, striking out five, walking none and giving up eight hits. C. Barker was the losing pitcher. He also went the distance.

Smyrna tallied one run in the second inning. David Bailey walked. Kenny Lewis singled, moving Bailey to second, and Norris Nelson brought him home on another single. But Pamlico tied the game on a double by J. Daniels and a single by B. Paul.

The Devils edged back into the lead in the third inning, with a double by Tommy McGee and a single by Joe Willis. The home

team was unable to score in the third.

Smyrna increased the lead to 3-1 in the top of the fourth, on a walk by Terry Lewis, a sacrifice bunt by Bailey and an error.

Pamlico scored one run in the sixth. Clarke doubled, then moved to third on a single by Brinson. A single by Styron scored Clarke. But the Devils' Kenny Lewis managed to retire the last two Pamlico batsmen. The home team could do nothing in the seventh.

Both teams committed only one error. According to coach Fred Bartholomew, the Devils are coming out of their slump. "We got hits when our men were in position. We aren't leaving as many men on the bases."
