

# Eagles Sink Beaufort 9-3 Friday

## Morehead Scores Six Runs in 6th

Morehead City splintered a 3-3 tie in the sixth inning of Friday's final bout with the Beaufort Seadogs. The Eagles scored six runs to take a 9-3 win, at Morehead City.

Donald Yeager went the distance for the victory. He struck out five, walked three and allowed seven hits.

Johnny Way took the loss, although he was relieved in the sixth by Mickey Bertram. Together, they struck out five, walked seven and gave up four hits.

Bertram walked two, gave up two hits and one run during his inning and a half on the mound.

The visiting Seadogs scored one run in the first inning. Clem Woodard doubled, and came home on a single by Brady Way. Yeager, the winning pitcher, led off with a single for the Eagles, and scored on three consecutive walks.

Beaufort picked up another run in the second inning to take a 2-1 lead. Bill Temple reached first, then second on an error by Bernie Ballance. He scored on a single by Leroy McIntosh.

Morehead City's Buff Chalk got a base on balls in the fourth. Ray Salter tapped a bunt down the third base line, and was called safe at first, while Chalk reached second. Mickey Brown singled to load the bases, and two batsmen later, Eddie Smith slammed one over the right field fence for a ground-rule double, driving in Chalk and Salter.

Behind by one, 3-2, the Seadogs tallied again in the fifth to knot the game at 3-3. Woodard made it to first on an error by Mike Clapsadl. He advanced to second on Wayne Merrell's ground-out, and scored on Brady Way's third hit of the afternoon, another single.

But the Eagles sent eleven men to the plate in the sixth inning to score six runs. Danny Clapsadl, hitting for Salter, drew a base on balls, and crossed the plate on a double by Brown.

Yeager was safe at first on a fielder's choice, while Brown was thrown out on the play. Eddie

Smith knocked out his second hit off the fence, scoring Yeager, then stole second. Smith scored on a single by Howard Barnum.

Mike McBride was hit by a pitched ball to join Barnum on base. Mike Clapsadl then slammed a double to score both men. Tommy Freeman, batting for Ballance, walked, and Chalk singled, to load the bases, but the Eagles were only able to score one more run.

Beaufort got two men on in the seventh inning, both on walks, but couldn't bring them home. The Seadogs committed two errors, while Morehead City was charged with four. The win gives Morehead City a 4-5 record. Beaufort's is 0-6.
