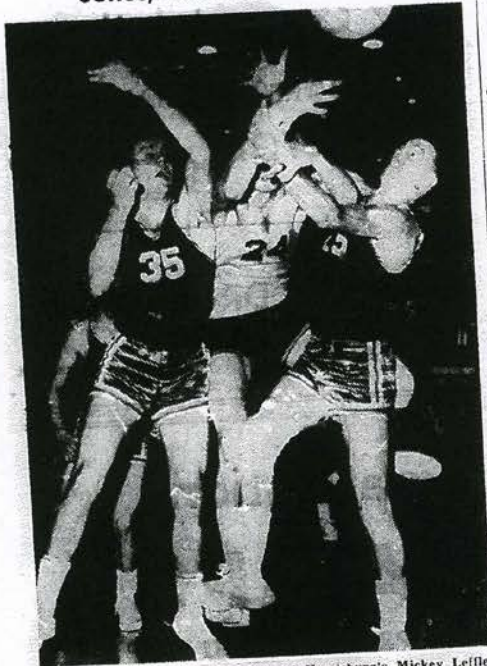


**Chow-Hound Champs Too**
