The Seadogs failed to get the other run that would have tied up the score and sent the game into a full seven innings of play.

Beaufort collected their four runs from five hits. Pamlico also had five hits.

Coach James Fodrie's boys now have a 1-3 overall season record.

The Seadogs traveled to Wallace-Rose Hill Thursday and will be in a home game when they meet Morehead City Tuesday.
