

Lewis Pitches Blue Devils To 3-0 Win

Makes Debut**

Terry Lewis pitched his first game for Smyrna Wednesday and gave the Devils a 3-0 victory over Camp Lejeune. The game was played at Smyrna.

Lewis went all the way, striking out nine Devilpups, walking three and allowing four hits. Smyrna lost its first meeting with Camp Lejeune 4-1. The Blue Devils' record now stands at 3-4.

The losing pitcher was Sellers, who was relieved in the fourth inning by Bullard. Together, they struck out five, walked three and gave up seven hits.

Smyrna scored two runs in the first inning. Joe Willis, Terry Lewis and Kenny Lewis singled to load the bases. Norris Nelson slammed out a double to score the first two base runners. The Devils picked up their third run in the second inning, after Tony Hancock reached first on a walk and second on a fielder's choice. He scored on a single by Tommy McGee.

Sellers, the losing pitcher, led off with a double for Camp Lejeune in the fourth inning, and was joined on base by Land, on an error, and Vain, a walk. But the Blue Devils executed a force out at home on the next play. Terry Lewis struck out the next two batters to end the Lejeune threat.

Joe Willis was two for three. Coach Fred Bartholomew adds that "Joe Boy" has gotten a hit in seven of his last eight trips to the plate.
