

Harris Hurls, Hits Braves To 1-0 Win

MURFREESBORO — Eric Harris, hurled a one-hitter Wednesday to lead the Chowan Brave diamondmen to a 1-0 victory over Mount Olive.

Chowan batsmen backed up Harris with eight hits but lacked punch to push over a run until the seventh inning. And then it was Harris himself who pulled the stopper.

Tommy Brooks started things off for the Braves in the crucial seventh with a single.

An infield out advanced Brooks to second. Alton Green struck out, bringing Harris to the plate with two outs.

Harris, a 185-pound freshman from Pantego, blasted a single to left to put the Braves in the driver's seat for the victory trip.

The only hit of the day off Harris came in the ninth inning and was of the infield variety, which with a good defensive play might have ended up as just another goose egg.

Bob Turlington busted up Harris' no-hit bid when he connected for the infield hit with no one out in the ninth.

A double play ended the game with a defensive tone as Settani

hit to Ronnie Hendricks at third. Hendricks went to Dicky Turner at second who ended the game by catching Settanni at first with his throw to Harold Newton.

Pete Bryant, a freshman short-stop from Roanoke Rapids, paced the Chowan hitting attack with a single and a double in three trips to the plate.

The Braves, 1-1 in conference play and 3-4 over-all, venture to Greenville Monday for a 2:30 battle with the East Carolina freshmen.
