

After losing two straight games, the Beaufort Scadogs accounted for their first baseball win of the year Friday afternoon as they downed the Newport Hawks 5-1 behind the effective three-hit pitching of southpaw Pud Hassell.

Pud was in control of the game all the way as he mixed an assortment of speeds and breaking pitches to hold the Hawks to three scattered singles.

Beaufort, meanwhile was getting to the Hawk pitcher, Chadwick for three runs in the first inning and then added two in the sixth for their five-run total.

Leading the hitting parade for the Seadogs were Ray and Pud Hassell and Chuck Lewis. Ray slammed two doubles in three trips to the plate and Pud and Chuck were each credited with two hits, including one double a piece. Mike Smith also got two hits for the Sea-
