

# Newport-Beaufort Twin-Bill Sunday Determines Playoff Spot

Probably one of the most important doubleheaders of the season will be played Sunday at Beaufort in the Carteret County Baseball League, as the current fourth place Beaufort club hosts Newport, in a battle for fourth place and a playoff berth.

Newport must win both contests Sunday to wind up the season in fourth place as the Agassiz has dropped out of the loop, and two postponed games that were to have been played between Beaufort and the Agassiz have been awarded to Beaufort.

Newport has a season's record of 10-12, and Beaufort's mark is 9-10. Beaufort was given two of the four games that were to have been played against the Agassiz.

Beaufort will play a single contest against Salter Path Sunday, Aug. 28, since that contest has a great bearing on second place in the league.

Atlantic, by virtue of picking up two forfeited contests from Morehead City this Sunday, winds up the season in first place with a 15-7 mark. In second place is Smyrna-HI with a mark of 16-8, and Salter Path is in third place with a 15-8 record. Their contest against Beaufort is yet to be played.

In fourth slot is Beaufort and Newport fifth.

Also playing on Sunday will be Salter Path at Smyrna-Harker's Island in a single contest. The winner will be named winner of second place in the standings should Salter Path defeat Beaufort on the following Sunday.

It is expected that Herbert Mason and Bradley McIntosh will be on the mound for Beaufort in the twin-bill with mound opposition offered by Mel Adcox and Earl Garner.

At Smyrna the visiting Salter Path nine is expected to start Jerry Pittman, and Manager Wilson Davis is expected to counter with Don Coates.
