

Blue Devils Whip Jasper 11-5 Monday at Smyrna

The Blue Devils handed Jasper an 11-5 defeat Monday at Smyrna. The game, scheduled for last Friday, was postponed until Monday because of rain.

Terry Lewis was the winning pitcher. He went six and a third innings, striking out eight, walking one and allowing five hits. Tommy McGee relieved him in the seventh, although the Devils were not in trouble.

The losing pitcher was Cumbo. However, Coonce and Wood shared the load. Together, they struck out five, walked four and gave up 13 hits. Jasper committed three errors to Smyrna's four.

The visitors took a three run lead in the first inning, then went scoreless before picking up their final two in the seventh. The Blue Devils came back in the

second inning with three runs, on three singles, a walk and two wild pitches, scoring Norris Nelson, Terry Lewis and Tony Hancock.

Smyrna got two more in the third, on two singles, a double, fielder's choice and two stolen bases. Joe Willis and McGee crossed the plate. In the fourth, the Devils scored five runs, on three singles, two walks and an error. Charles Lawrence, Kenny Lewis, Willis, Doug Damren and Nelson did the honors.

They picked up one more run in the seventh, on a single by Lawrence, a walk and a fielder's choice.
