

Pamlico Takes 6-0 Victory Over Newport

Pamlico took a 6-0 victory over Newport Friday. The game, played at Pamlico, was the Hawks' fifth loss against four wins.

J. Lupton was the winning pitcher. He went all the way, striking out five, walking one and giving up five hits. Jimmy Aycock was credited with the loss, although he was relieved in the fourth inning by Leo Winberry. Together, they struck out none, walked one and allowed five hits.

The Hawks committed five errors during the contest, while Pamlico made two.

The home team scored three runs in the first inning on a double, a single and four errors. Pamlico picked up two more in the second on two base hits, a hit batter and three throwing errors. A hit batter, a base on errors, a throwing error and a ground out scored the team's final run, in the third inning.

Newport threatened only once. With two outs in the sixth inning, Cecil Hardesty got a single. Norman Dunn and Leo Winberry followed with singles to load the bases, but the Hawks were unable to bring the men home.
